Cost and time studies using the BeamRider laser guided line marker – Athletic track marking

Location – Midlothian Council

Date – 31st January 2007

Method – To initial mark a 400 metre 8 LANE running track (including a 100 metre straight)

Study

To initial mark a 400 metre running track with 100 metre straight – Study revealed an average of 8 hours per track to complete this task using traditional methods.

Traditional method	BeamRider
8 hours per track 3 man operation @ £12 each per hour	1.45 hours per track 2 man operation @ £12 each per hour
Total for one track = £288.00	Total for one track = £42.00

Saving of £246.00 (€372.00) per marked track

If a council or a contractor has twelve 400 metre running tracks to mark out the money saved in labour on this task equates to **£2952 (€4461), or the man hours freed up to carry out other essential works equates to **74 hours** or **9 average working days****
